| Planning Committee decision: The committee resolved to object to this application for the following reasons: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Activities currently witnessed at the site do not appear to be related to agriculture. A planning enforcement order is being actioned because Leeds City Council also believes that the site is not being used for agriculture. • The area of land being farmed is claimed as 6ha, which the committee believes to be insufficient to justify the number of buildings being proposed. • The adjacent public footpath linking Rakehill Road to Elmwood Avenue is not as shown on the plan supplied with the application. The footpath actually meets Rakehill Road at the site entrance, which is about 45m to the west of the location shown on the applicant's plan. The committee had concerns over the possibility of a public footpath emerging into a site where increased numbers of heavy vehicles would now be moving. | | |
