3 EVENT TO COMMEMORATE THE HUNDREDTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE END OF WORLD WAR ONE

It was **resolved** that the budget for the event on Hall Tower Hill be increased by £300 to pay for the additional cost of a minibus to allow Scholes residents to attend and to cover any other contingencies, proposed Cllr. Hassell, seconded Cllr. Maude, all in favour.

A sixteen-seater would be booked. Cllr. Maude had attempted to get three quotes but only one had been forthcoming and it was agreed that this quote be accepted. Cllr. Maude would remain with the driver at all times to direct him according to need. Four pick-up points in Scholes were suggested;

- The lay-by on Scholes Main Street near the garage
- The shop on the corner of Station Road/Rakehill Road, Scholes
- Outside the library, Scholes (Station Road)
- Saint Philip's Church, Main Street, Scholes.

The first pick up would be 5:30pm and further picks ups were anticipated after that at twenty-minute intervals. Consideration was given to picking up residents direct from their homes if they were unable to get to the pick-up points. The service would run until 9:30pm.

In addition, residents living in Potterton had expressed an interest in the minibus service and there would be a pick-up point at Morgan Cross.

Local coffee mornings and other community events would be used to raise awareness of the offer of this minibus service. Regulations regarding driver break times were noted.
