

This Sunday is Remembrance Sunday and a time to remember those who have lost their lives in wars past and present. Each year many people find comfort from gathering at the war memorial of each village to spend time in silent reflection and be part of the communal act of Remembrance.

Unfortunately this year we are unable to do as in previous years and so the Church has put together two 'Services' (one longer and one shorter) for each village that will go live on Sunday morning. Each has been produced so that if you watch it from the start time the minute's silence will fall at 11am. The services are:

1. One starting at 10:15am with about 10 minutes of pre-service images and music followed by a full Remembrance Sunday service with hymn, anthem, readings, sermon and prayers, followed by the act of remembrance (calling the names of the fallen, laying the wreaths, Last Post, minute's silence and reveille finished off with the National Anthem).

2. The second starts at 10:45am and just has the Act of Remembrance part of the service (for those who aren't interested in the Church Service part).
