<p>3 Matters Arising</p> <p>AW to send copies of meeting minutes to KL</p> <p>4 (iv) PM not able to check on listed buildings as they are on private land.</p> <p>4(v) ID to produce a plan showing PROWs within the Parish</p> <p>4(ix) SW to send AW revised text for 5.5.4 and E4 Village Hubs</p> <p>Cherished views: PM to draft an article for Parish Newsletter/ AW to send KL images of Views for uploading onto the Parish Website in September</p> <p>Traffic Data: PM approached James Gray regarding traffic data. LCC has the data but as it has commercial value and they are not in a position to release it.</p> <p>It was also reported that the planning condition relating to upgrading the Coronation Tree junction may be dropped as it is considered that residents do not want any changes there.</p> <p>JB suggested that from ELOR to the start of the houses on Leeds Road should be 40mph and at this point a “village gateway” should be provided and the speed limit reduced here to 30mph. JB to send details to SW so she can forward to Ward Cllrs.</p> <p>MR also suggested gateways for Barwick.</p> <p>Health</p> <p>PM discussed the recent emails received regarding future health provision noting that a new medical centre has been proposed opposite John Smeaton. There was concern that this could impact on the viability of the existing GP practice in Scholes. PM to draft a letter to Manston Surgery who run the practice in Scholes. The letter is to be sent from the PC.</p> <p>Education</p> <p>It was noted that a new primary school is due to open opposite John Smeaton in September 2027. Also there is land allocated on Morwick Grove for the expansion of Scholes Primary School.
